Position Description

The Bilingual Domestic Violence & Sexual Assault Therapist is a member of the Domestic Violence & Sexual Assault Services Team and is responsible for providing short-term individual counseling and support groups for survivors who speak English and Spanish.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide confidential short-term individual, survivor centered counseling for survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault in Spanish and English.
- Provide linguistically and culturally appropriate crisis intervention, safety planning and assessments of the client's psychological and emotional status.
- Provides a safe and therapeutic environment according to established policies and procedures.
- Organize and facilitate support groups for survivors in English and Spanish.



- Work collaboratively with agency staff to plan and implement educational, social, and therapeutic events and educational programs for Spanish-speaking clients.
- Work collaboratively with agency staff and allied professionals to coordinate client services.
- Obtain and participate in clinical supervision and work towards clinical licensure.
- Provide back-up coverage to advocacy services.
- Provide support to the Youth & Children’s Counselor with Spanish-speaking parents.
- Provide interpretation and translation services for programs and clients.
- Be a team player and work with all organization staff to ensure that all clients are provided quality services.
- Participate in agency on-call rotation.
- Maintain and audit appropriate client files; process and enter VAdata information.
- Maintain accurate statistics and records for client services provided and complete grant reports as needed.
- Participate in weekly case review, supervision, and service coordination meetings.
- Obtain 20 hours of job-related training annually.
- Other duties as assigned.
